


U.S. GDP % Change

U.S. Unemployment Rate





Monthly Employment Changes, in Thousands of Workers


(Job Gains or Losses Estimated This Month vs. Last Month)


Institute for Supply Management's Purchasing Managers' Index








ITA PRIORITIES


E.U. Imports to U.S. vs. U.S. Exports to E.U. in 2011
